Oxford Detachment Updates

April 1 – June 30, 2023

2023-460356

Employee of Oxford Frozen Foods reported two vehicles were stolen sometime overnight from the Oxford Frozen Food plant in Oxford. Entry was gained by cutting a chain link from gate lock at the rear entrance off of Black River Road. Vehicles are a black Ford F150 and a white Dodge Nitro. CCTV footage shows three hooded adults, faces not visible. No entry was gained to buildings. Suspects are unknown. BOLO was sent. The Nitro was recovered. Matter is still under Investigation.

2023-565004

911 call of a disturbance in progress – COM reports her client is in a rampage. SOC is throwing things at people. Members attended and SOC was arrested and charged for Mischief and Assault with a Weapon, and released back to the home.

2023-767303

911 call of an assault in progress. COM screaming her boyfriend was assaulting her. Members attended but SOC had left on foot. SOC turned himself in 4 days later, was arrested and charged with Assault, Forcible Confinement and Mischief. Conditions of no contact were placed. Due back in Court in September.

2023-674762

911 call for a neighbour dispute. COM stated that his neighbour is having a bonfire and it is getting too close to one of the houses and that the neighbours are arguing with each other. The SOC started swinging a shovel and throwing things at the COM. Members attended and arrested the suspect for Assault with Weapon and Mischief. Statements were taken from the witnesses and confirmed charges. Adult male was released on Undertaking. Matter is before the Court.

Members were parked at the Irving in Oxford when a vehicle came in rather fast. Member followed the vehicle to the Oxford Frozen Food plant and attempted to pull it over. Members observed the known suspect in the driver's seat. Member located the vehicle at suspect's residence with the engine being still hot. Suspect was arrested for Flight from Police and issued an Appearance Notice. Suspect was also issued a fine for Operating Motor Vehicle without Valid Driver's License, Driving Motor Vehicle without Motor Vehicle Liability Policy, Operating Unregistered Vehicle. Criminal Code charge is before the Court.

2023-933108

911 ATV complaint - Complainant who did not leave their name reported ATV's were flying past and doing stunts in Oxford. Member attended, parked the PC on Horton and proceeded on foot. Member was finally able to locate the ATV. Driver was known to Member. Member informed SOC that the ATV was going to be towed and he would be issued the SOT's accordingly. When the member went to move the ATV SOC freaked out and started yelling and grabbed a stick and started to aggressively swing it as he walked towards the member. Member pulled the taser, turned it on and when the red dot hit his chest the SOC ran. THE taser was put back in the holster. While running the SOC threw the stick at the member nearly hitting him. SOC was issued an Appearance notice for Assault on Police officer. Matter is before the Court.
