**2023-1461117**

**911 threats complaint.** Complainant advised he was walking his dog, locked his keys in his car and was waiting for wife to attend when a male subject walked by screaming at him, threatened to beat his face in and threatened to beat him if he was still there when he returned from his walk. The complainant advised this is the third interaction with this Subject. Statement was obtained. The male subject of complaint was arrested for threats and released on undertaking with conditions of no contact. The matter remains before the court.

**2023-1567811**

**Mischief – Damage to Property.** Complainant reported that her daughter, while trying to gain entry, broke her patio door. Members had been in attendance on previous Mental Health act incident. Complainant believed her daughter needed to be brought to the Hospital due to her declining mental state. Since the subject of complaint did not threaten to harm herself or anyone else, member advised this incident did not meet the threshold to be detained under the IPTA. However, SOC was arrestable for Mischief if COM wished to provide a statement to support a charge. Complainant declined to provide a statement so no charges were laid.

**Cannabis Act Offence.** A vehicle was stopped for speeding and issued a fine. While issuing same, member found Cannabis not stored legally and issued a fine for Illegally transporting cannabis in vehicle.

**2023-1813803**

**Break and Enter.** Complainant reports that someone broke into his vacant property. This was the 5<sup>th</sup> occurrence reported in the last month. The Subject of Complaint may have kicked in the door, nothing was missing, and there is minor damage to the door. Complainant stated he believes the SOC is sleeping on the couch inside during inclement weather. Complainant was frustrated by the B&E's and is requesting additional patrols be made during the night; he stated he would look into getting surveillance but would be satisfied with additional patrols. There are no suspects or surveillance. Members provided additional patrols. File concluded.

**Arson.** Complainant reports house fire next door where an elderly lady lives. Members on scene almost immediately. Homeowner already outside and stated she lives alone and was able to remove her cats. Fire coming out of attic window, Fire crew on scene and put out fire quickly. Victim reports she has a wood oil heat combination furnace and the woodstove was lit, Fire Chief determined creosote buildup was cause of the accidental fire. File concluded.

**Arson.** Complainant drove by skate park saw 3 cars hanging out in the parking lot and it look like they have a bonfire going. Oxford fire advised as well. Fire and Members attended, no indication of any fire was located, complainant updated.

**Assault with a Weapon.** Complainant 1 and Complainant 2 reported an altercation between two subjects on Cove Road. Statement obtained from subject 1, detailing an assault, and threats with a possible firearm from subject 2. Investigation ongoing.

**Child Pornography.** Online story platform reported a user, who uploaded stories depicting child sexual abuse. User associated to IP address located in Oxford. Production Order served on internet provider for internet subscriber. Internet subscriber identified as subject of complaint. Investigation ongoing.
