3. **Amendment to the Land Use Bylaw – First Reading**

A letter has been submitted to Council regarding an agricultural use property requesting a re-zoning of Main Street permitted uses, for the purpose of assisting the property owner in expansion of their agricultural business.

Linda proposed to amend the Land Use By-Law, that was approved by Council on July 13, 2009, by inserting i) Existing Agricultural Uses under

heading 13.0 Main Street Mixed-Use Zone (MMZ) and under the subheading 13.2 Permitted Uses.

If approved by Council, a Notice of Intent will be sent out to the public by September 19 via Website, social media, and local paper, and the second reading (final reading) will be given in a Special Council Meeting on October 3, 2022, following the scheduled COW meeting at 6pm.


