Mayor's Corner

The Town recently applied to PURB for a water rate increase. This was necessary to increase our water reserve funds so Oxford can finance replacing our aging water lines and the Pugwash Road reservoir. In order to qualify for 50 cent dollars, the town has to demonstrate it can finance its share of major projects. The PURB have set the new rates which will be reflected on the first water bills issued in 2026. Thankfully the increases are not outrageous and Oxford water rates are pretty well in the middle of the pack when compared to other municipalities in Nova Scotia. The new rates will be posted on the Town of Oxford website at a later date.

The downtown appearance has been improved by the transformation at the building housing the Pizza L'amore. A big shout out to all those involved in this project.

On a personal note I want to say how gratifying it is too see how many folks show up for Remembrance Day services at the cenotaph. This is one Oxford ritual that seems to attract an attentive crowd every year, regardless of the weather. The Veteran banners are a welcome addition to the town landscape.
