



Please adhere to the below guidelines to make it a memorable and safe experience for all:

1. Deadline for Applications:

The deadline for applications is November 28th (day before the parade)

2. Cancellation:

In the event of inclement weather, an announcement regarding cancellation and rescheduling will be made on the local radio stations by 8 am on parade day. The parade will be rescheduled for the following Friday (December 6th, 2019)

3. By-laws:

By-laws prohibit the throwing of candies and/or promotional materials. If your group would like to pass out candies and/or promotional materials it must be done person-to-person only.

4. Floats:

- All floats should have the name of the company/organization prominently displayed on the on the **Right Side** of the float for the convenience of Parade Judges and to assist with award presentations.
- All floats must be of proper construction to prevent any chance of breakdown during the parade and have proper vision for the driver as well as ventilation. Drivers must remain with their floats.
- No one may get on or off a float once it has started the parade route.
- All entrants should me use of Christmas lighting and be decorated in keeping with the parade theme.
- Festive music is encouraged on the floats.
- For safety reasons all groups should have a prearranged area for assembly away from the parade site.
- At the end of the parade route, all floats must exit! There will be no stopping allowed on Waverly Street!

5. Solicitation:

There will be NO solicitation for cash and/or tickets sales along the parade route.

6. Mr. & Mrs. Claus:

NO float shall have a person in a Mrs. Claus or Santa Claus costume

7. Keep Pace:

Please keep a safe space of 30 feet behind the entry in front of you to ensure that the procession moves smoothly. We need your help in maintaining the pace!
