# Oxford Detachment Updates

## 2019-283922

A motor vehicle collision was reported to police the same day in which the driver of the damaged vehicle, stole the car of an innocent bystander who had stopped to help. The same individual was identified as being involved with a vehicle reported stolen overnight from a home in Pugwash. A Warrant was issued and a male was later located and arrested and is currently remanded awaiting Show Cause Hearing. Male was charged with Theft of Car, Theft under \$5000, Possession of Property over \$5000, Mischief over \$5000, Failure to comply, and Operation while disqualified. Both vehicles were recovered.

## 2019-191870

After receiving a complaint of a vehicle driving around private property an adult male was located and charged for impaired driving by alcohol and for operating a motor vehicle without an driver's license and also issued a warning for operating a motor vehicle without valid registration.

## 2019-246663

Report received of a break and enter into a camp. An adult male was arrested and charged for same. He was living in one of the camps for a short period of time. At least five other camps were broken into and various items were recovered.
